

## **Guidelines for Restricting/Opening Mass Gatherings – COVID-19**

- 1. These guidelines pertain to mass gatherings of more than 50 participants
- 2. These guidelines are for events on City owned property. They do not apply to private events or events held on private property
- 3. They do not apply to sporting events. (Soccer, baseball, etc.)
- 4. Events will be cancelled on City owned property when 2 out of 3 metrics to measure the spread of COVID-19 virus are exceeded using the Harvard Global Health/King County, Washington model.
- 5. The metrics used are:
  - a. Rolling average of the new cases reported by Franklin County for the past 14 days.
  - b. Rate of hospitalization for Mercy Hospital-Washington in the past 14 days compared to the prior 14 days.
  - c. Rate of deaths in the past 14 days compared to the prior 14 days.
- 6. The City of Washington will calculate the metrics weekly on Monday to determine events that may need to be cancelled for that week.
- 7. Events on City owned property will be allowed to resume once one or less of the metrics used have exceeded target criteria.
